Our children are our life! In this weeks פרשה the פסוק says, 'וה' ברך את אברהם בכל'. רש"י famously points out that the word בכל is equivalent in גמטריה to the word בן - son. Both equal 52.

Why does the תורה use the word בכל, “with everything” to refer to אברהם’s son?

From the perspective of אברהם, his son, יצחק, was everything to him. יצחק represented his future, his legacy, all his dreams and hopes. The word "בכל" teaches us that our children are everything! They are the future of our מסורה, the future of כלל ישראל’s continuity. Our children are the greatest gift given to us by הקב"ה. They mean the world to us, and we would do anything for them.

As we do our utmost to invest in our children, we will זוכה to the בכל of ברכה, having everything!
