



Points from the Principal

During our cycle assemblies we discussed the plant cycle of a red pepper. We tend to draw cycles like circles, with one stage leading to the next. But did you know that we counted a pepper to have more than 300 seeds? That's over 300 future plants! And each pepper plant can have about 10 peppers! That's over 3,000 peppers coming from 1 pepper! (We planted a bunch!) The circle became a spiral.

Mitzvahs work the same way.

The 4th grade brought food from our food-drive to the Shabbos room in a hospital thinking they were just bringing food, so that those doing the mitzvah of bikur cholim could have what to eat. In actuality, the presence of a group of respectful and polite boys out to help their community made a kiddush Hashem for the hospital staff... a whole different mitzva!
