With his פטירה the world is a different place.

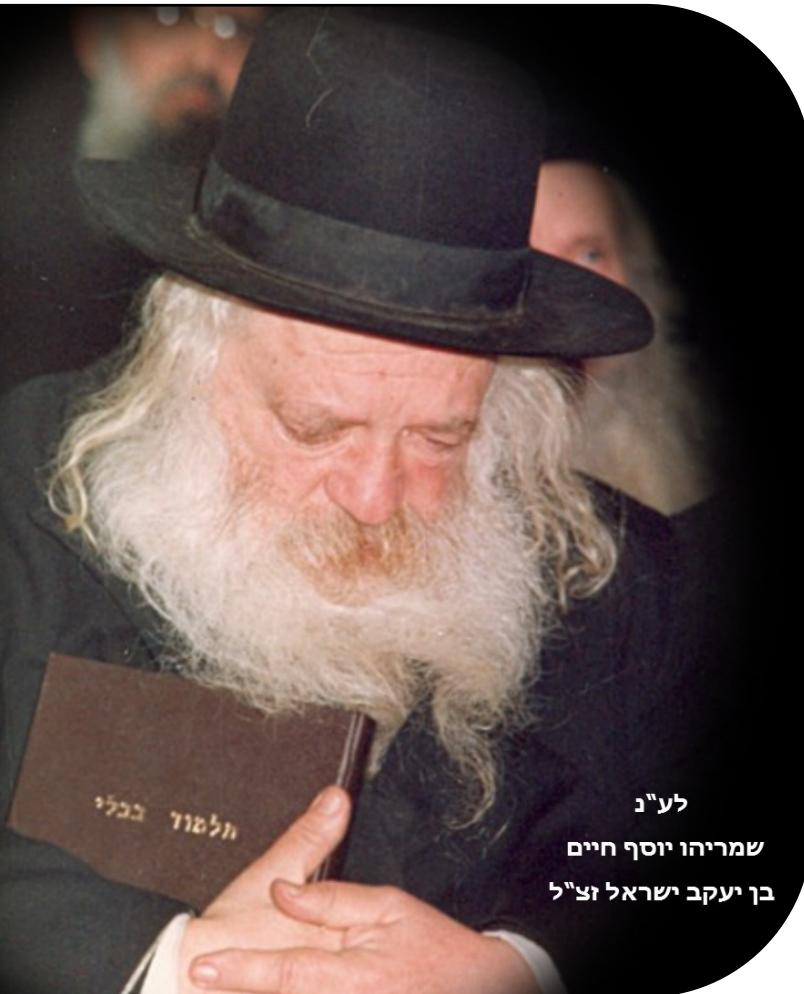
With his פטירה, we also have an obligation to fill some of the void he left.
