May this new year of 'עבודת ה' bring us all to true simcha!

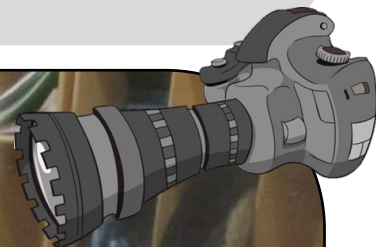

May this חודש ניסן reflect the חודש ניסן of the past and bring with it the גאולה once again!

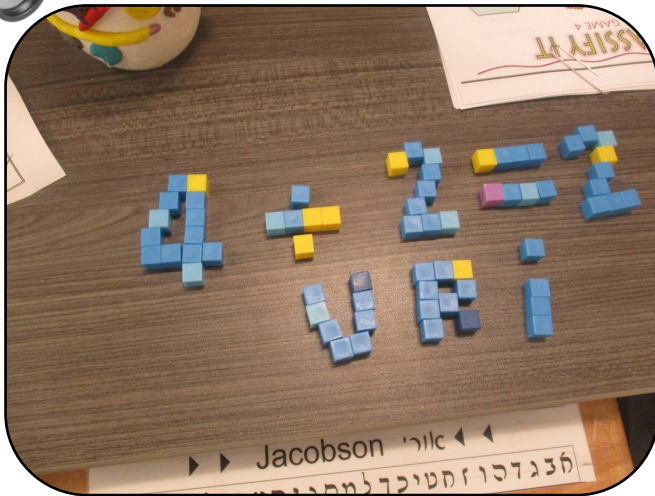

Rabbi Schulman's dynamic classroom has 'deeply invested in their preparation for the ליל סדר

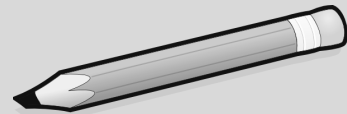
