ר' משה's sense of responsibility toward Klal Yisroel knew no bounds. His time, every second of it, was very precious, but if it was used for Klal Yisroel's sake, then it was being spent wisely. He always made himself available to answer halacha shailos in person, by phone and answering letters by mail. ר' משה did not wait to be asked when he saw help was needed. Once the elderly shamash (someone who helps keep the shul in order) needed help in placing the סכך in the yeshiva's sukkah. He asked ר' משה to send some bochurim to assist him. Instead, ר' משה climbed up on the ladder and put the סכך up himself. He took אחריות to help out when something had to be done.

One hot summer day, ר' משה was sitting and learning outside on the lawn. There was another man learning outside with a little boy. The little boy dropped his ball and it rolled down the hill into a ditch. ר' משה noticed, and took אחריות to help out. He jumped up and ran down to the ditch to fetch the ball. ר' משה did not wait to be asked to take responsibility, he noticed what needed to be done and did it right away!
