As the senior class of our younger division, they demonstrated for all what Shalom is all about.


May the beauty of this election be echoed globally with the coming of Moshiach, במהרה בימינו!




In our middle school, more than 40 Bnei Aliya were mekabel bl'n to wash neggel vasser by their beds during our grand Negel Vasser Giveaway!


