To grow, we need routine.

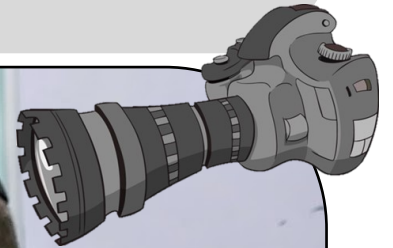
That is what the month of מרחשון is for!

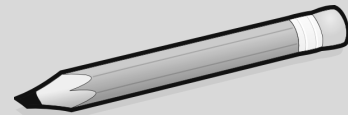

When middos matter the most, they are BOTH great options!



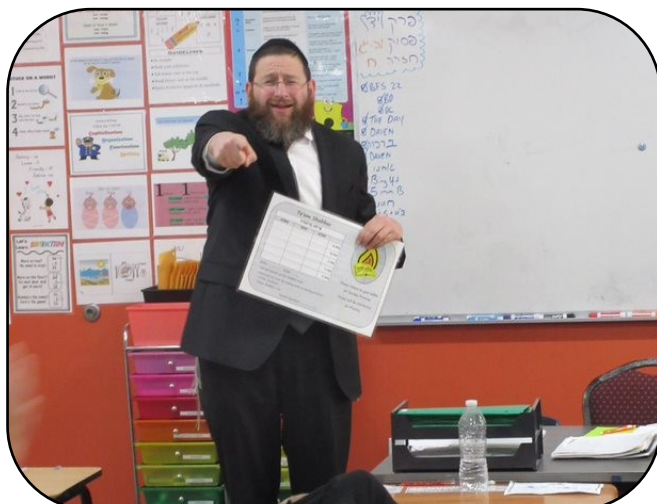

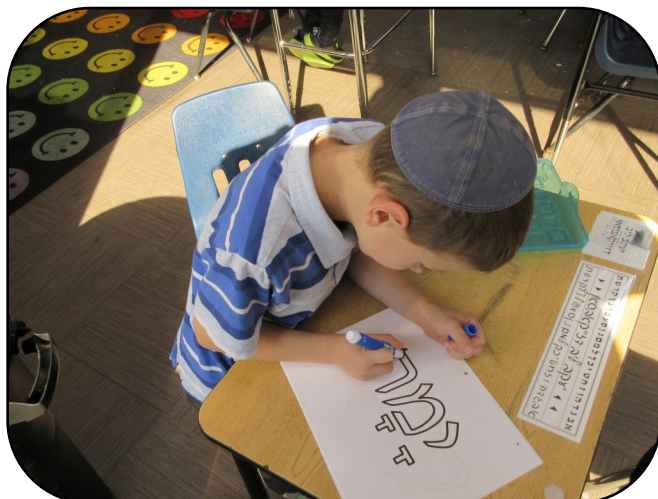

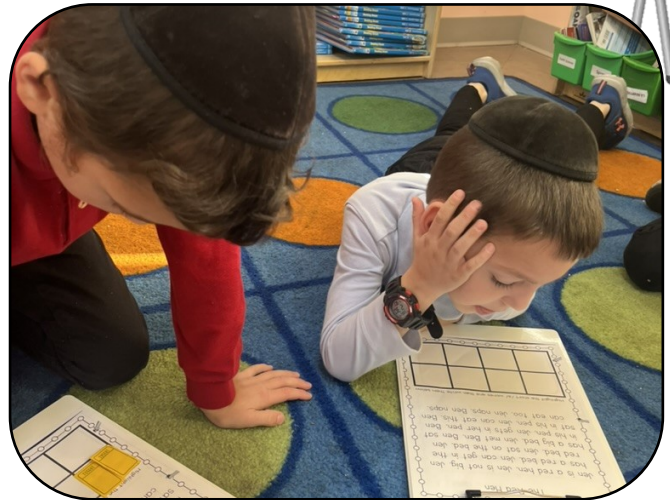

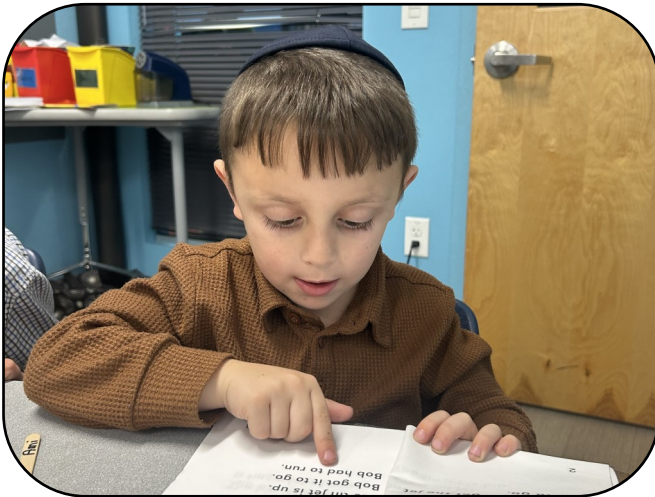

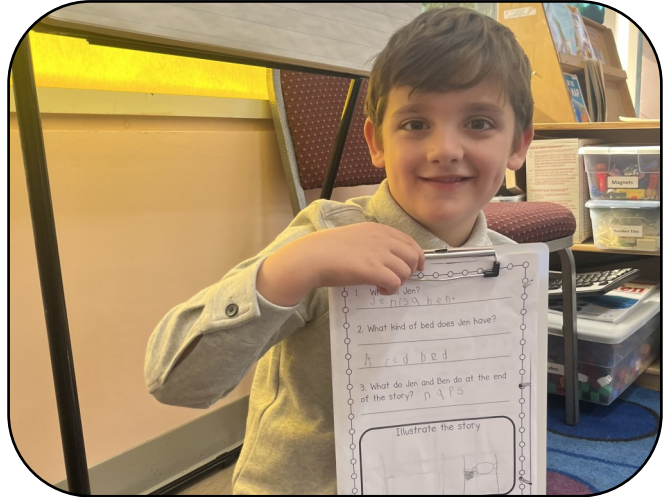
