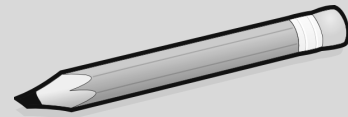

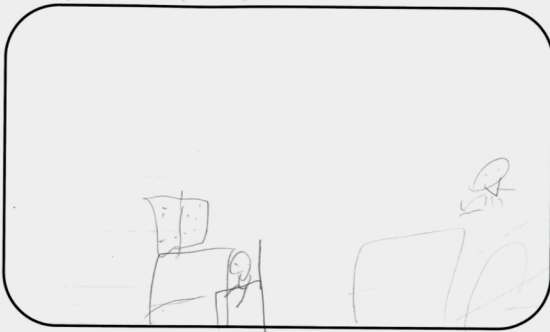

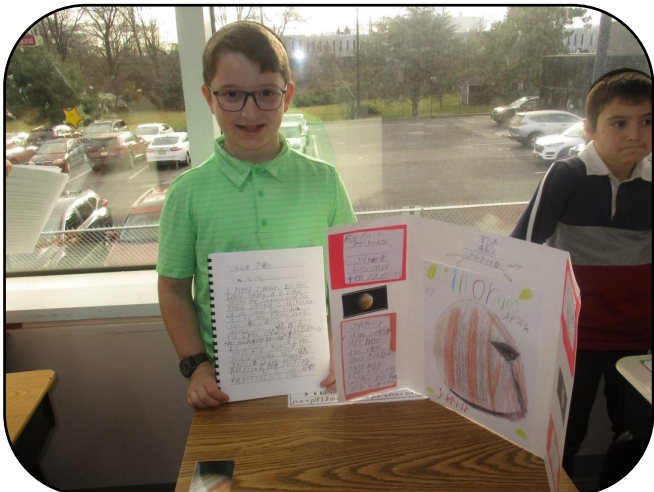

Scratch offs, challenges, Talking Tuesday and prizes... We made over 150 connections (in complete sentences of course!) and many more are coming in! Keep up the great work!

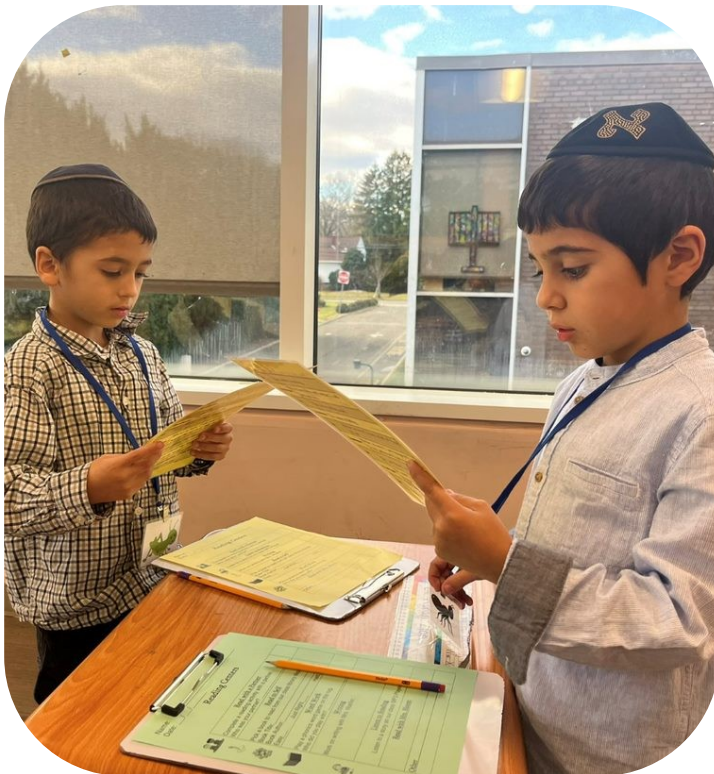

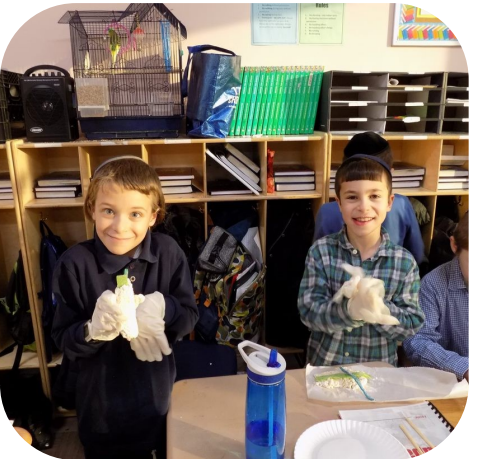
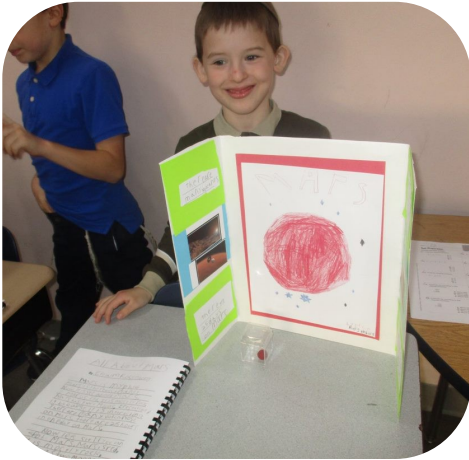
